April 12, 2025.**

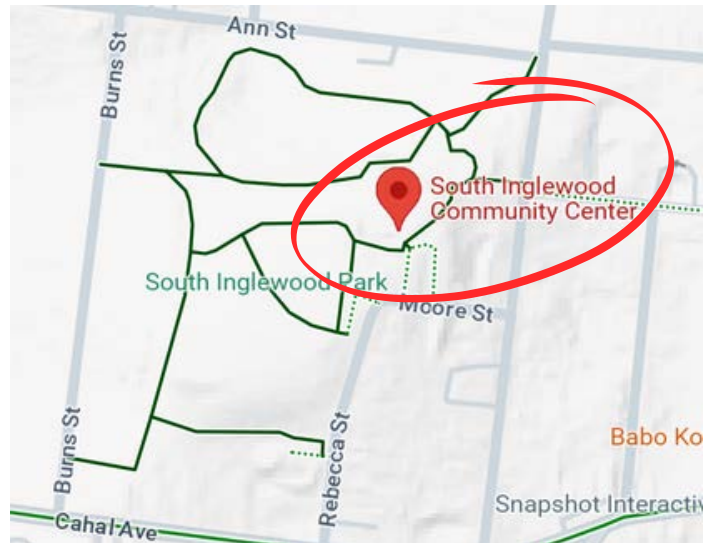

This event brings together a wide variety of bicycling enthusiasts – from supporters to mechanics, from beginners to experienced cyclists, from commuters to mountain bikers to cargo haulers and others. Last year’s festival had 200+ attendees; in 2023, it was 125+. We are growing!
